



# How Do You Stay Informed of Emergency Information?


• **Make sure you have at least one of the following in case there is a power failure:**

- Battery-powered radio (for listening to local emergency instructions).
- National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) weather radio receiver (for listening to National Weather Service broadcasts).



• **Find out how your community warns the public about severe weather.**
