- Application fee waiver for active duty & veterans (www.cmich.edu) payment method 'mail in check'. We will then waive your fee.

- Masters of Science in Administration requires 36 credit hours (12 classes)
- Program can be completed in 18 months (less if you double up face to face & online)
- Courses can be taken online, face to face in the classroom or a combination of both
