 Application fee waived for active duty and veterans. Payment method "mail in check." How heard? Military.

**Program Information**

Master of Science in Administration requires 36 credit hours (12 classes).  
 Courses can be taken face-to-face in the classroom, online, or a combination of both.  
 Program can be completed in 18 months (less if a combination of face-to-face and online classes are taken).

**Tuition Information**

Tuition discount offered to all active duty and veterans. Program qualifies for tuition assistance.  
 Veteran certifying official on site.  
 Financial aid and scholarships available for those who self-pay.
