Refund Policy

Students who officially withdraw from the institution or who reduce their semester credit hour load shall have their tuition and mandatory fees refunded according to the following:

% Refund	Withdrawal
100% Refund	Withdrawal before the first day of the term.
75% Refund	Withdrawal if not more than 18.75% of the term has elapsed.
