Program Overview


The Veterans Career Transition Program, operated by the Institute for Veterans and Military Families at Syracuse University, is delivered at no cost to post-9/11 veterans, their spouses, and spouses of active duty military. Paid for in entirety by a grant from JPMorgan Chase & Co, the VCTP offers specific education and training programs, business/industry coalitions focused on veteran employment and information about national and state-level opportunities and benefits for veterans and their families. The VCTP is offered through an advisor-led cohort admitted quarterly.

Through online courses—accessible from any location, at any time—participants have the opportunity to gain an understanding and insight into the corporate culture of civilian business/industry, government and other civilian sector employment opportunities.

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION

- You become a Syracuse University student.
- You have an assigned academic advisor to assist with reviewing your professional documents and to serve as an accountability partner in completing the coursework.
- You receive a non-credit, certificate of completion from Syracuse University when you finish each course.
- Courses launch quarterly – January, April, July, and October of each year.
- You have access to the program for up to one year.
- Once all program requirements are met, you can have 1 industry certification exam fee paid for by the VCTP.

ELIGIBILITY

VETERANS: You must be a post-9/11 veteran who has already separated or retired from the military, OR who will transition from military service to the civilian workforce in the next 18 months. Service members must have served at least one day on active duty after 9/11/01. The VCTP is also open to National Guard and Reserve members who have served on active duty for purposes other than training or drill since 9/11/01.

SPOUSES: Spouses of eligible veterans, as well as spouses of all active duty service members military are eligible to apply to the program. Spouses can also access coursework developed in partnership with MOAA specific to the professional needs of military spouses.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE FOR VETERANS AND MILITARY FAMILIES (IVMF)

The IVMF is the first interdisciplinary national institute in higher education focused on the social, economic, education and policy issues impacting veterans and their families post-service. Through our focus on veteran-facing programming, research and policy, employment and employer support, and community engagement, the institute provides in-depth analysis of the challenges facing the veteran community, captures best practices and serves as a forum to facilitate new partnerships and strong relationships between the individuals and organizations committed to making a difference for veterans and military families.
