LTC Brian J. Wallace is a native of New York. He enlisted in the Army Military Police Corps in 1990. He was later commissioned as a Medical Service Corps Lieutenant in 1998 through the Army Green to Gold Program.

His previous assignments include Company Executive Officer and Medical Supply Officer, 86th Combat Support Hospital; Medical Platoon Leader, 3/187 Infantry Regiment (RAKKASANS); Plans, Training, Mobilization and Security Officer, Blanchfield Army Community Hospital, Fort Campbell, Kentucky; Medical Troop Commander, Support Squadron, 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment, deployed in support of OIF I and III and Chief of Materiel at Evans Army Community Hospital, Fort Carson, Colorado.
