

Mission Readiness

Modern State-of-the-Art full spectrum, maneuver friendly training environment in the Midwest supporting the "Total Army"

World-Class ranges and maneuver area supports live-fire training on all Army systems and munitions including hellfire missiles (first generation) and Multiple Launch Rocket System

Diverse terrain with varied land contours includes large open **prairie land suitable for heavy maneuver** and densely wooded, restricted terrain for light forces, capable of supporting two Brigade Combat Teams in the field simultaneously.

Unique, **offset Impact Area creates large usable maneuver block** (3707acres) enabling collective live fire training in the maneuver area vice on a range

Integrated Training Environment features **State-of-the-Art** Mission Command, Combat Systems, Aviation, Medical, Digital Training Facilities and Military Schools co-located in a Regional Training Campus, enhanced by partnership with FT Leavenworth

Regional Collective Training Capability for the Midwest supports 22,000 off-post Reserve, National Guard, ROTC/JROTC Cadets and Joint Interagency, Intergovernmental Partners from 31 different states (average) training annually



Ready and Resilient

Community health, resiliency and transition programs & facilities, enabled through partnerships, holistically address Soldier & Family fitness

New \$343M hospital and medical campus that is a state of the art evidence-based design with the capability of an **inpatient behavioral health ward**

The Soldier For Life, Transition Assistance Program, partnership with Kansas State University, Comprehensive Soldier and Family Fitness transition, and other **partnerships have enabled transitioning Soldiers** to be served by a first-of-its-kind "university pathways to employment" program w/ **19 local, regional, & national companies**

The only Army Benefits Center in the United States

FT Riley's **Insider Threat Analysis** Program is a DOD Defense Security Enterprise **Award winning process** designed to identify High Risk Behavior & Home Grown Violent Extremists before they act

Home of a Regional Comprehensive Soldiers and Family Fitness (CSF2) and is co-located with the Army Wellness Center, and next to the Army Community Services in the Resiliency campus

Irwin Army Community Hospital has partnership agreements for **18 programs w/ 12 universities and 6 inter-service programs**



Sustainability

Environmentally friendly and sustainable with nationally competitive deployment capability enables stewardship in fiscally constrained times

Modern railhead with state-of-the-art capability, 24-hr capable, adjacent to Union Pacific main line (runs through FRKS) allows loading a heavy BCT in 36 hrs

3 local airfields available for simultaneous use (Forbes Airfield in Topeka, Salina & Manhattan Regional Airports)

2nd lowest Energy rates of 6 Divisional installations and FY14 Infrastructure and Services **costs are lowest in aggregate of similar installations**

Capital investments of \$1.8B are complete and combined with regional & local investment and support; postured well regionally for current fiscally constrained times; **we are in sustainment mode**

Over **40% of maneuver lands are leased for annual agricultural production** compatible w/ military operations, bolstering the regional economy while substantially reducing the threat of wildfires on the installation at no expense to the Army

Winner of Army's FY2013 Conservation Team Award (FY2013 DoD runner-up) and recognized by the American Bird Conservancy and the Nature Conservancy jointly as one of the 500 most important bird areas in the entire U.S.



Community

Optimal living; mutually engaged civic leaders and partners; linked to an unprecedented history; now state of the art enabling first class readiness; a great place to come home

KS cost of living lower than national average – FT Riley BAH and energy costs are 2nd lowest among division-level posts

KS laws help Soldiers and families – no tax on military retirement pay; charged in-state tuition rate at Kansas Regents Universities; easy transfer of occupational licenses & certificates

1st Infantry Division and FT Riley partners with 8 nearby counties and 29 cities – **support over 1k public events annually**

Adopt-A-School Program **partners with 17 Unified School Districts & 69 schools** throughout Central Flint Hills Region

Kansans voted **FT Riley as one of 8 Wonders of KS History**

Oldest and only Forces Command installation with major, land-grant university 20 minutes from gate – Kansas State University – offering direct access to Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Services; intellectual capital via no-cost academic internships; and **over \$450k in merit-based scholarships to military-connected students**
