

4-4 Cavalry Coat of Arms

The volcano represents the unit's participation in the Battle of Bud Dajo in the Philippines. The inverted kris, a weapon of the Moros, signifies the 4th's victory. The regiment's saber is held high in victory. Below the volcano is the unit's crest.



4-4 Cavalry Unit Crest

The yellow shield is symbolic of the unit's cavalry heritage and the weapons represented signify victories from the Civil War. The cannon represents the capture of Hood's artillery, the downward saber is from the defeat of opposing cavalry at Murfreesboro, the bayonet and blue background signify the attack on Selma, and the arrow is for its success in Indian campaigns. The saber in the background is held high in the pose of a charge.
