Privacy Act Statement

Authority: Section 3012, Title 10, USC

General: The Privacy Act of 1974 requires that, whenever personal information is solicited from an individual and the information will be filed so as to be retrievable by reference to the name or other personal identifier of the individual, he or she must be advised of the authority for soliciting the information, the principal purposes for which the information is intended to be used, the routine uses which may be made of the information, whether disclosure is mandatory or voluntary, and the effect on the individual of not providing all or part of the information.

Principal Purpose: To conduct risk assessments of Soldier's behavior.

Routine Uses: Any information you provide is disclosable to members of the Department of Defense who have a need for the information in the performance of their duties.

Disclosure Mandatory: With the exception of questions 3, 4, 5, 13, 26, 29, and 31, which you are not required to answer, all other questions are mandatory.
