Irwin Army Community Hospital (IACH)

- IACH has recently installed Audio Care, a DoD-wide system. Audio Care is a telephonic reminder system integrated with TRICARE on Line. This system serves to remind patients of upcoming appointments and is set to also remind patient of requested filled prescriptions not yet picked up. In the future, refill requests will be available via the World Wide Web.
- The Office of the Surgeon General Vaccination Policy has been distributed. Flu vaccine is scheduled to be released from manufacturers by the end of October. We will offer vaccinations to high priority patients. Patients with chronic illnesses such as asthma, lung disease, immunocompromised conditions, diabetes, etc., and household contacts with individuals, as well as patients 50 years of age and older and children aged 6-23 months should be vaccinated. These categories will be higher priority based on the Army Office of the Surgeon General's policy, with active duty soldiers deploying to Operation Iraqi Freedom to receive the highest priority category. - Use ICE to help us serve you better. ICE (Interactive Customer Evaluation) is a web based customer feedback system. You can provide an evaluation of more than 170 services on Fort Riley or communicate directly with the manager of a service via ICE.
- You can access ICE several ways. The quickest is to click on the ICE link on the sidebar of the Fort Riley home page (www.riley.army.mil). You may also access our site via the ICE homepage (<http://ice.disa.mil>) and then drill down through the map to Fort Riley. In either case, you will reach a search page listing categories of service. The names of the organizations you can rate will appear when you click on the service category. The comment card will come up when you click on a service name. At the bottom of the comment card you will also find a dialogue box in which you can enter comments. Your comments are most valuable to our service providers. If you wish to see how others have rated a service in the past 90 days, click on the “Report” box. General information about the service can be obtained by clicking on the “Info” balloon.
- ICE is a worldwide customer feedback system supported by the DOD Office of Quality Management. You will find all branches of service and installations worldwide whose services you can rate or see how others have rated them. This may be important to you if you have been TDY and wish to rate services received or if you are going to another installation and want to know how users evaluate a service.
- ICE is administered by the Plans, Analysis & Integration Office at Fort Riley. If you have questions about this service or wish to develop a comment card for your organization please call 239-2540.

Provost Marshal Office

- Speeding and accidents continue in parking lots. Be careful when backing your vehicle; drive defensively.
- Bicycle, skateboard, rollerblade, etc. safety is important so please use all safety devices and equipment. It's the right thing to do, and it's post policy.
- Motorized scooters operated in Kansas must be registered. Any person who operates a self-propelled motor scooter on the streets of Kansas must have a valid drivers license. Safety equipment is, of course, required. Motorcycles and mopeds stored or operated on Fort Riley must be registered with the Provost Marshal's office. Register in the same manner as registering an automobile in accordance with CG Policy 04-2. This statement includes ATV's.
- Be aware of and obey crossing guards at schools. Erratic driving can have serious consequences. Children cross at crosswalks before and after school and play outside during the school day. Please look out for our children.

Directorate of Public Works

- **Energy / Water Conservation:** Water lawns/gardens seldom and deeply – 1” water 1-2 times/week. Mow grass taller to conserve water. Authorized thermostat settings during the cooling season are 76 to 80 degrees. Be sure to keep windows and doors closed when the cooling system is energized. Be sure to turn off computer monitors, appliances and lights when not needed.

Not only does it save energy, but also it helps keep the room cooler. Saving on electric demand during this peak season saves Ft Riley energy dollars throughout the year. Funds saved in the energy account go to improving the quality of life for soldiers and families.

- **Recycling Reminder:** All on-post housing occupants are reminded of their responsibility to recycle to the extent possible. All recyclables except yard waste and large pieces of cardboard are to be placed in the blue recycle bags and placed next to your trash containers the day of your scheduled pick-up. The blue recycle bags and a Resident User's Guide are issued at the time of assignment of the quarters, and additional bags can be obtained at no cost at the self help store. Please do not use the blue recycle bags for everyday trash or non-recycled items. Information on the recycling procedures are in the Resident User's Guide and in the Housing Handbook, page 48.
- **Smoke Detectors in Quarters:** Smoke detectors can save lives. Residents are responsible for ensuring they are in good working order. **Never** remove the backup batteries from the detectors to use for other purposes. **Never** remove the detectors from the ceilings. Replace the batteries when the detectors start beeping. That is the warning sound for expired batteries. Replacement can be done by occupants or as a service order.
- **Barbecue Grills:** Must be kept several feet from the House, when in use, because of the intense heat they generate. Fire Regulations prohibit the use of barbeque grills on enclosed porches and balconies. Parents must watch children while Barbequing, to prevent serious injury.
- **Recreational Vehicles:** Must be stored in garage, carport, or in on-post/off-post storage lots. The Installation has two free of charge storage lots; spaces are available. Register your item for on post storage at the Self-Help Store, 289 Cameron Ave. Recreation vehicles found stored in housing area parking lots or on streets will be ticketed.
- **Fall Clean Up: Fall Clean Up Begins 27 September 04. All Housing Areas will be inspected. Tickets will be issued for noncompliance with standards.**
- **Self-Help Store:** Open Monday, 27 September, 8:00am-5:00pm. Lawn care items are available. Tool checkout is on first come basis with a 24-hour return policy.
- **Dog Walkers:** Animals must be on a leash. Feces must be picked up and disposed of properly.
- **Mold:** Keep areas well ventilated; use exhaust fans while cooking or bathing. Open window in bathroom a few inches if there is no exhaust fan. Treat areas with Clorox solution (1 cup Clorox per gallon of water).
- **Trash: Should be placed out for pickup on your designated day. Carts are to be retrieved and returned to quarters on trash day.**
- **Housing Policies:** Policies can be found in the Housing Resident Policy Handbook. Residents are required to read and abide by all policies. Copies are available at the Self-Help Store, 289 Cameron Ave.
